Students will collaborate on a school wide mural, which will demonstrate how dinosaurs may have lived.

- Use scientific inquiry skills
- Demonstrate knowledge of the Earth's environment
- Demonstrate geographic knowledge
- Think symbolically
- Remember and connect experiences
- Participate cooperatively and constructively in group situations
- Recognize difference between living and non living things
